It is said that many young children are left as orphans by their own parents to grow in utter poverty and totally uncared atmosphere. Total neglect of physical needs and health slows mental growth and puts these helpless children not only in filthy surroundings but socially dangerous situations as well. These children are on the street when they should be going to school.

They should be eating healthy food in place of the scraps they are able to put together. They should be cared for instead of the abuse they are subjected to platform, benches etc. are not a substitute for a homely bed.

These orphans and destitute children are living in most pitiable conditions not on their own choice or faults. With such factual background "CARE & COMPASSION - GOA" has been formed to meet the above sited dire needs in the form of a Trust.



Girls Home...

The Charitable Trust was established in the year 2003 at Panaji, Tiswadi, Goa, to take care of deprived children and give them all the care possible. Mr. Prince Aaron Golden and his wife Mrs. Sujatha Prince came across several destitute children who were orphans semi orphans & from broken homes. They had a vision and burden since october 1998 to do something for these children, So Prince and Sujatha started praying that God would enable them to start a home for these deprived children and give them the best in life like any other privileged child.

The Charitable Trust is registered as children's home in the name of Care and Compassion-Goa, separately as girls home & boys home.

Boys Home...

There are two homes, one for boys and the other for girls. We have staff who live with the children and take care of them, cook for them, clean the house, wash clothes and drive them to school and back. We have a new land in Sarzora village, Margao that is donated to us and we need to develop that by building a new home for boys and girls, guest rooms, playground, garden and so on. We need sponsors to help in the building project.

Our Projects...

Children's Home: Taking care of 24 children (16 girls & 8 Boys) in our homes. Food & clothing, shelter, medical education, Travel, recreation and giving them a standard life.

We need help: School & college Education of the children. Building a new permanent home for boys and girls in the new land donated to us. Medical Expenses for the children. Salary for 10 staff. Rent of the two homes for boys and girls.

Tailoring Class: Free Tailoring classes are given daily to women from very poor background & widows. Every batch we have 8 ladies doing their 6 months courses. We give them certificates to stand on their own feet and earn their living by stitching. We have 6 sewing machines in all.

We need help: Salary for Teacher, Clothes, and stitching materials.

Street Children's Club: Provides free informal education to street children, who don't have the privilege of going to school.

We need help: Salary for Teacher, Study Materials, Toys, Snacks / refreshments for the children.

HIV Infected Families: Support a few families that are HIV infected with resources like supply of old news papers to make paper bags and sell them in the super markets. Raw materials to help families to make food items and sell it in the market and earn their living. We also support those affected Children to meet their school needs.

We need help: Old news papers & Raw materials. Children of Compassion Home study daily in regular English Medium schools & colleges in and around Panaji, Goa. They are quite healthy but normal ailment do arise and doctor's fees and medicines costs often exceed the orphanage's budget for medical aid. They require sufficient and clean clothing to clothe themselves. Since they are all growing children, there is a regular need for new clothes. At Compassion Home a balanced diet is provided. Morning Breakfast, Afternoon meals, Evening tea & snacks and Night dinner are the daily routine. Sponsor a child and help them to survive.
